

Setting up the random image module with the premade header images

Hello,
thanks for purchasing the „MP Marcon“ Mambo/Joomla template from www.pixelsparadise.com

This small manual guides you step by step through the random image module setup process. The random image module is a Mambo/Joomla build in module which is easy to use and to configurate.

After you install the template you must:

1. Log into your Mambo/Joomla backend
2. Open your module manager (click on “Modules” -> “Site Modules”)
3. Select the “Random Image” module to access the modules config screen and hit the “Edit” button in the upper right corner
4. Change the settings:

4.1 Select module position “**user7**”

4.2 Enter “**jpg**” as image type

4.3 Enter the path to your image folder. The template creates its own header image folder during the templates installation called */header*. So the path is :

templates/templatename/header/

Replace “templatename” with the name of the used template (e.g. mp_marcon).

4.4 Enter the width and height of the Image in pixels (px). The premade header images have a width of 490px and a height of 180px.

4.5 Mark one, some or all “Menu Item Links” within the right “Pages/Items” text select field. You can mark more than one Menu Item Link by holding down the “Ctrl” key. The random image module will only appears on the marked menu links, so be sure you’ve marked a minimum of one menu item links.

4.5 Save the changes

4.6 Ensure that the “Random Image” module is published

5. To change the images you can upload other images or delete existing images via a FTP tool. The template installed seven header images already, but you can upload as many images as you want to the */header* folder inside the *templates/templatename/* folder .
